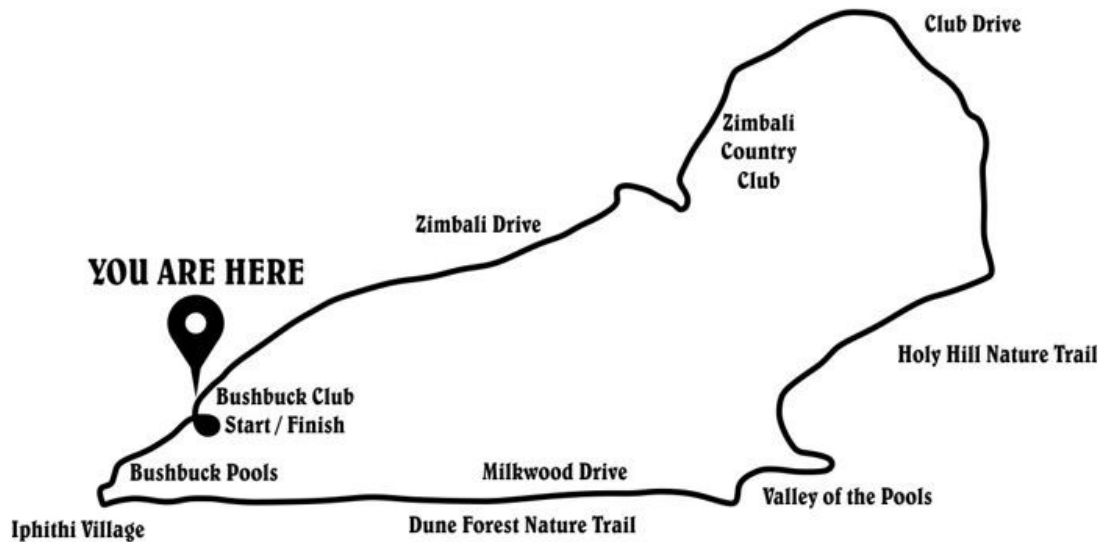


ENJOY THE ESTATE'S MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL

Where else can you cycle through Coastal Forest, see wildlife and enjoy elevated views of the Indian Ocean!



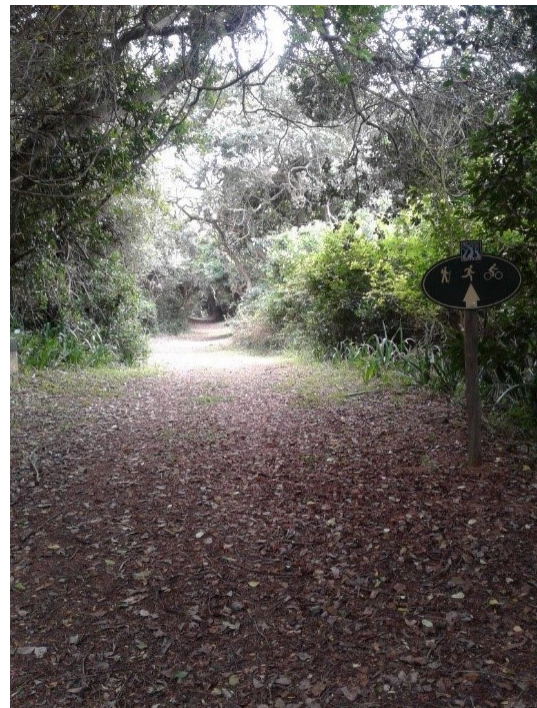
Have an adventure in your own back yard and be prepared for an amazing outdoor experience. Our new Zimbali Coastal Resort Mountain Bike Trail is rich in breath taking scenery and eco-attractions and is an unforgettable way to explore your natural surroundings

Start at the car park of the Bushbuck Club go past the bushbuck pools, head down the cart path into the dune forest pass through the security boom and enjoy the ride through the low forest canopy.

If you follow the trail signage, the track through the dune forest takes you over the stone bridge right past the Valley of Pools on your right. The path then joins the

Eagle Trail for a challenging climb up Holy Hill, aptly named as it was zoned at inception to remain as an untouched, undeveloped forest reserve.

The sand track winds its way through the giant forest tree species and is approximately 7km long with the highest point on elevations up to 88m. Continue towards the edge of Zimbali where you will find yourself crossing over the bridge trail. On the climb up and you will find yourself entering Iphithi Village and as you follow the signage it will take you back along Zimbali Drive and you will end your adventures back at the Bushbuck Club.



Remember, sharing is caring on the cycle tracks and you may come across walkers and even the odd bushbuck! Try to keep to the left and slow down when you pass others.
